

The Twenty-Sixth Annual North Jersey Regional Science Fair will be held next spring, March 20-21, 2009, at Rutgers University, in New Brunswick, NJ.

Win scholarships, trips, and cash awards!

Four students and their sponsors will win expense-paid trips to the Intel International Science and Engineering Fair. Two trips will be awarded to students in grades 9-10 and two will be awarded to students in grades 11-12. Last year, the NJRSF gave over \$30,000 in cash and prizes.

To enter, pay close attention to these steps:

- **Do your background library research**, and fill out the Research Plan, ISEF Forms 1A and 1B. Three signatures are required on Form 1B yours, your sponsor's, and your parent's *before you begin your work*.
- Talk to your sponsor about safety. Your sponsor must fill out and sign the ISEF Safety Checklist. A sponsor can be a parent, teacher, or science professional capable of reviewing your science project and ensuring that the project adheres to all ISEF rules and regulations.
- Check the ISEF rules to ascertain if any other forms are required for your project. If so, you must submit all of your forms to our Scientific Review Committee by December 1. See your sponsor or our website for rules and information.
- AFTER your forms are completed and properly signed, begin your research.
- Enter the fair, using our website http://njrsf.org.
 - You must enter by **February 1, 2009**.
 - Print out the cover sheet for your project, available from the website or by email. Use it to mail in all your ISEF forms in a single package, with your entry fee.
 - All of your paper forms must be received by **February 1**.
 - Submit your abstract via the website before February 28.
- Watch for your final instruction packet, arriving by mail around March 13, with maps and a detailed schedule. This information will also be available on the website.
