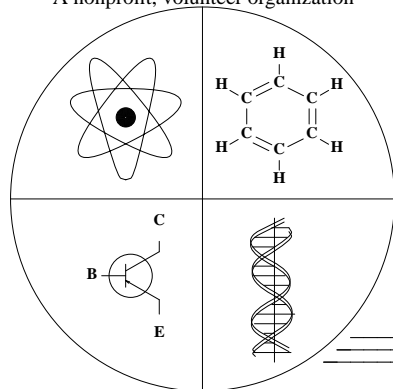

- 6:30 p.m. Judges' briefing, judging room, for Category judging.
- 7:00-9:30 p.m. Category judging, **STUDENTS AT PROJECTS!!!**
Advisors and parents not allowed in exhibition area.

Saturday,

- 8:30-9:00 a.m. Judges' briefing (judging room). Students arrive at projects, for judging at 9 a.m. The exhibit area is in the College Avenue Gym (the main gym). The judges room is in the annex--closed to students and advisors.
- 9:00 a.m.-Noon Judging interviews, STUDENTS AT PROJECTS.** Judging for special awards, ISEF Team Awards, and symposium finalists. Advisors and parents not allowed in exhibition area.
- 10:00-10:30 a.m. Advisor meeting, in the gym balcony
There will be a short refreshment break midmorning.
- Noon Announcement of symposium finalists.
- Noon-1:15 p.m. Lunch break. Food service available 11-2 in Student Center.
- 1:15-4:15 p.m. ISEF Finalist Symposium in Student Center Multipurpose Room. Students, advisors and parents encouraged to attend. This session is open to the public.
- 1:00-6:30 p.m. Exhibits open to public.
- 4:30-6 p.m. Break, food service NOT available in Student Center. Use this time to view other projects, if you like. There may be press representatives around as well.
- 6:15-6:30 p.m. Pre-ceremony audience participation, puzzle solving event Student Center.

- 8:30-9:00 p.m. Projects removed. Please dismantle your exhibit as quickly as possible after 8:30 p.m. NOTE that projects not removed during this time may be discarded. We cannot be responsible for material left beyond 9:00 p.m. Projects are not to be removed early. Doing so may result in disqualification of your entry.
